About the Education Offered

The Florida Swimming Pool Association is an approved course sponsor by the Florida Construction Industry Licensing Board (CILB), the Board of Landscape Architects (BOLA) and the Electrical Contractors' Licensing Board (ECLB). The FSPA CE Advisory Committee reviews all courses and instructor qualifications to ensure high quality and relevance to industry members' needs. As a provider, the Association is required to monitor attendance and how courses are conducted, issue Certificates of Completion to persons who complete each course, and verify information provided to the Bureau of Education & Testing (BET) upon audit of any individual licensee. Florida CILB License Requirements

Under Chapter 489 F.S., all license holders must complete at least one hour of Workers' Compensation (WC), one hour of Workplace Safety (WS), one hour of Business Practice (BP), one hour of an Advanced Module (ADV) on the Florida Building Code and one hour pertaining to Laws and Rules (L&R) within the required 14 hours of continuing education.

Obtaining Florida CE Credit




